

English

In English we are reading and retelling the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk' using this text to develop our writing. We are going to focus on the elements needed to build up a good story. We will also be looking into writing non-fiction with our bean diary.

Mathematics

In Mathematics the children will be securing their knowledge and mastering the skills needed in place value, the 4 operations of calculating and fractions. There will also be a focus on measuring units of temperature.

Science

In Science we will be looking at everyday materials and their uses. We will decide on the best material to make a famous landmark out of which is strong and weatherproof. The children will then make these themselves.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at iconic buildings from around the world and where they can be found. We will also cover what the 7 continents are and how cities are different to villages.

History

In History we will be learning about the extinction of dinosaurs and how they used to live.

Physical Education

The children are going to be doing a lot of work using the I-pads this term and learn how to store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

Music

In music we will listen to the Carnival of the animals recorded music and guess the animals that are in the carnival. We will also listen to KS2 play their new instruments.
