Pupil Premium Allocation 2015/16

The Government provides additional funding for certain groups of pupils e.g. those who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM), or who have been eligible over a period of the past 6 years.

For the year 2015-2016, St Weonard's Primary School has been allocated £6,600 to spend on initiatives to ensure that these children reach their full potential – academically, socially, emotionally and behaviourally.

For this academic year we have allocated the money in the following way:

- ◆ Materials to support the implementation of THRASS intervention groups
- ◆ Intervention groups for literacy and numeracy
- ◆ Funding for extra-curricular visits and clubs

If your child does not have Free School Meals, but may be eligible because of your family's income level, please contact the school office (in confidence) to register them.

Even if you do not wish your child to have the meals, this would mean the school could still claim Pupil Premium funding that may be used to help your child
