

English

We will be reading 'The Return' by Aaron Becker. Our focus is to explore and develop ideas for their own story, incorporating higher level vocabulary and punctuation. Explaining 'Why' and 'How', link to our Science topic.

Mathematics

The children will be extending their knowledge of place value to 5 and 6 digit numbers. Formal methods of addition and subtraction will be revised along with strategies for multiplication and division. Knowledge of fractions, shape and angles will be applied when solving problems.

Science

In Science, later in the term, children will carry out investigations connected with Forces, but first we will be venturing into Space, finding facts about the planets.

Computing

Pupils will be learning to touch type using the BBC Dance programme. They will be encouraged to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly; recognise acceptable/unacceptable behaviour; identify a range of ways to report concerns about content on the Internet.

Art and Design

The children will sketch and taste fruits from around the world. They will design and make a healthy eating chocolate bar. Pupils will have the opportunity to explore work by American artists.

Physical Education

Pupils will swim on Monday afternoons. They will have a weekly lesson with our P.E specialist on Thursday. This term, the focus is on playing competitive games including football, netball, hockey and rugby.

Religious Education

Forest Schools

During the first half term, children will be taking part in weekly Forest School sessions. They will learn about the minibeasts and plants found within their Forest School site.

History and Geography
