



Summer Term Topic 1st-19th June



For topic, we are first going to look generally at the continent of South America, and then at Brazil in more detail. You can present your work in anyway you wish –handwritten and/or using technology, is absolutely fine. You can share your work with me by taking a photograph and uploading it onto Seesaw.

On the world map, can you locate South America and label the 13 countries. Then label the equator and the oceans that surround South America. Can you also add the main mountain range that runs down the left side of the continent.



Brazil is the largest country in the southern hemisphere. Find as many interesting facts about Brazil as you can. Areas that you could research are location, capital city, currency, rivers, climate, land marks, tradition dress or indigenous people. Present your facts in a fun way eg. cartoon character speech bubbles, factfile, draw pictures.



List the 13 countries of South America along with the main language spoken in each country. Why do you think that European languages are spoken in South America?

Write a brochure to encourage tourists to Brazil. Include interesting facts and information that will interest visitors. Think about where you would like to visit in Brazil and explain why.



Find out the population (the number of people who live in each country) of each country in South America. Which country has the most people living in it? Which has the fewest people living there?

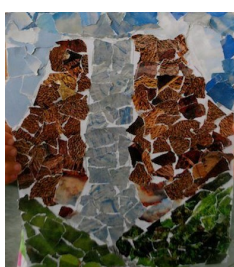


What type of food is eaten in Brazil? Write out a 3 course menu (starter, main course and dessert) that you would like to try. Are you brave enough to try and cook it?

Create a quiz about Brazil. Write 5 facts about Brazil and 5 facts about England. Mix them up and see if someone else can sort them into the correct country.
