

### Music

Children will be learning what ballads are, how to identify their features and how to convey different emotions when performing... Selecting vocabulary to describe a story, before turning it into lyrics structure of a traditional ballad

### Spanish

The children will learn all about colour and shape, recognising the spoken and written word. Children will also learn about the Gaudi mosaics and have a go at creating some of their own!

### PE

This term children will be investigating dance as well in preparation to performing at 'Moving Targets'. Alongside this, we will be working with Paces to further develop our game skills.

### Geography

In Geography this term, the children will develop their skills by looking at why settlements develop around volcanoes. They will learn about the layers of the earth, and how movement creates changes in land formations.

### Enrichment Activities

The children will have the opportunity to take part in our "24 Club" and "Chess Club" during their lunch breaks.

### Maths

We will continue to look at the four rules which include the formal written methods, as well as using our reasoning skills to develop mastery. This term, we will continue to follow White Rose focusing on measurement (converting units), decimals and then linking all of our previously learnt knowledge to understand the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages (Year 6). We will also learn about ratio and algebra.

### English

In English, this term we will be focusing on setting and suspense writing. We will focus on using technical language within a variety of text types, as well as, spelling, grammar and punctuation. In reading, we will practice their inference and deduction skills by studying a range of texts.

### Science

We are starting the term with our topic on light. We are looking at different sources of light and sorting them into natural and manmade. We will carry out investigations into how light travels, reflections and how to create and change the size of shadows before looking at refraction. After half term we will be looking at habitats, including where different species live and why, and how they have to adapt to any new environments

### Art

This term in Art the children will be developing their colour mixing skills, using shades and tints to show form and create 3D when painting. Children will learn about composition and plan their own still life to paint, applying chosen techniques.

### DT

In DT, children will research existing playground equipment and their different forms before designing and developing a range of apparatus to meet a design criteria.

### History

We will be starting this term looking at what changed in Britain after the Romans left. Investigating key features of settlements, how Britons felt and changing beliefs under the Anglo-Saxons. We will be looking at many aspects of this period of time including Christianity and emerging monarch system. We will be concentrating on our skills of identifying changes and comparing different periods of history.

### Computing

Year 3 and 4 children will be learning all about video trailers building their understanding of purpose, use of photo and video editing software and evaluating before moving on to website designing. Year 5 and 6 will begin with Data handling- Mars Rover and data collecting before moving on to the history of computers and looking specifically at Bletchley Park.

### RE

This term children will be investigating what it means to be Muslim in Britain today. Then moving on to why the Torah so important to Jewish people?

### PSHE

Citizenship- An introduction to the justice system; how parliament works; and the role of pressure groups; learning about rights and responsibilities, the impact of energy on the planet and contributing to the community
